**Please read the TCS Prom dress guidelines. If the guidelines are not followed in the spirit or in the action of the intent of the guidelines, he/she will be denied admission to the prom event until attire is appropriate.**

All dress attire should be chosen with Christian modesty in mind. The following list will help you make the appropriate decisions when choosing your prom attire.

### Ladies

- Dresses must be pre-approved by administration.
- Dresses can not be strapless.
- No cleavage can show.
- Dresses can not have a back that is lower than the bottom of the shoulder blade.
- Dresses must be fingertip length or longer. Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds fingertip length.
- No cut-outs or flesh-colored material that give the illusion of skin from the top of the cleavage down to fingertip length in front, and from the bottom of the shoulder blades to fingertip length in back.

### Gentlemen

- Button-up, collared-shirt (must be tucked-in)
- Tie or bow tie is required for senior court presentation but optional for the banquet.
- Dress slacks (or equivalently nice pants with no holes/frays/discoloration) and a belt.
- No writing is permitted on the clothing.
