 Daugherty. A front and back photo with the student wearing the dress as it will be worn at prom is required for approval.

The dress code for prom is as follows:

All dress attire should be chosen with Christian modesty in mind. The following list will help you make the appropriate decisions when choosing your Homecoming attire.

Ladies

- Dresses must be pre-approved.
- Dresses can not be strapless.
- No cleavage can show.
- Dresses can not have a back that is lower than the bottom of the shoulder blade.
- Dresses must be fingertip length or longer. Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds fingertip length.
- No cut-outs or flesh-colored material that give the illusion of skin from the top of the cleavage down to fingertip length in front, and from the bottom of the shoulder blades to fingertip length in back.

Gentlemen

- Button-up, collared-shirt (must be tucked-in).
- Tie or bow tie is optional.
- Dress slacks (or equivalently nice pants with no holes/frays/discoloration) and a belt.
- No writing is permitted on the clothing.
