## A Message From the Dean of Instruction:

At TCS we are always looking for ways to help our students succeed academically. In addition, we continuously strive for improved communication with our families! One item that has been brought to our attention over the years is the sizable transition students make from elementary to junior high. Elementary students receive their assignments in a folder that is sent home daily for parent signature. This folder lets parents quickly know how their student's conduct was for the day and any homework for that evening. Once students move to junior high, they are asked to independently keep up with their assignments. This can be a challenge in addition to the added responsibilities that come with the junior high grade levels.



To help our students succeed in these transition years, we are implementing student planners with our 6th through 8th grade students. These planners will be passed out to students on Monday, September 9th and will begin being used immediately. Junior high teachers have already met and collaborated on the best way to utilize these planners as a means to remind students of their homework and as an added layer of communication home to you. Junior high teachers will ask students to write down their assignments in their planners and use the monthly pages to notate upcoming tests, quizzes, projects, etc. Each day when students go home, they will have a quick way of seeing everything that was assigned for the day and the upcoming weeks.

We are asking for your support in this effort! We are requesting parent signatures on their child's planner each weekend as a way of letting our teachers know that you have seen your student's assignments. We are working on a monthly incentive for those students who show a high percentage rate of parent participation. If your child already has a planner that they prefer to use, they may continue to use that one in lieu of the ones we will pass out on Monday. Please do not hesitate to reach out with any questions. We are incredibly grateful for our partnership with our families to provide Biblical education to our students!

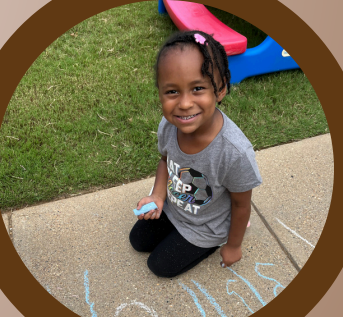
Our 2025 yearbook is now on sale! Order early to secure your copy at the lowest price! The current price won't last long, so order today! Click on the yearbook to place your order.


