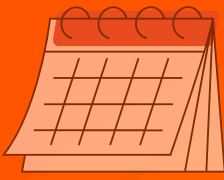

Many of our high school students signed up to take the District ACT Test on Tuesday, October 15th. On testing day, please have your child to school no later than 7:45am. We plan to begin testing promptly at 8:00am.

 - *a bottle of water.

Testing should conclude around noon. Students are allowed to check out when testing is over.

12th grade students who are not taking the ACT will not be required to be at school this day. 10th and 11th grade students who are not taking the ACT will only be required to come in for their afternoon classes (6th/7th/8th periods) beginning at 12:50pm.

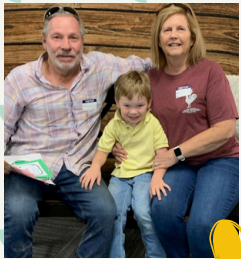


